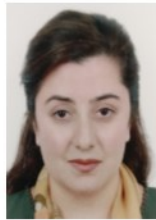
A delicious sehri followed the match, it was a splendid opportunity for the MOL family to show some sportsmanship in the sleepy slow days of Ramadan!
