CSR Activities

In order to commemorate the World Disabled Day, a one day Free Eye Camp was organized at Ghurzandi village in Lachi, Kohat District where a medical team comprising doctors and paramedics from Al-Shifa Trust Eye Hospital, took part to provide free eye examinations to about 342 patients.

The OPD remained operational from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm where besides the examinations, medicines and spectacles were also provided to the patients. In addition, a Free Medical Camp was held at the Government Girls Primary School Ghoroza where Sahibzada Sami Ullah, Assistant Commissioner Kohat and Dr. Musharrarf Khan District Health Officer (DHO) Kohat, jointly inaugurated the activity. During the day long activity about 815 patients including 310 women and 217 children were examined. Prescribed medicines were also provided to the patients, free of cost. Overall, MOL Pakistan has already served about 5,573 patients through such camps in the area.

A Sports Gala was held in Karak on December 23 where the local youth participated in Cricket, Football, Volley Ball, Tug of War and Kabaddi competitions. Deputy Commissioner Karak, Mr. Shafi Ullah Khan was the Chief Guest at the closing ceremony and distributed shields amongst the winners and runners-up teams.
