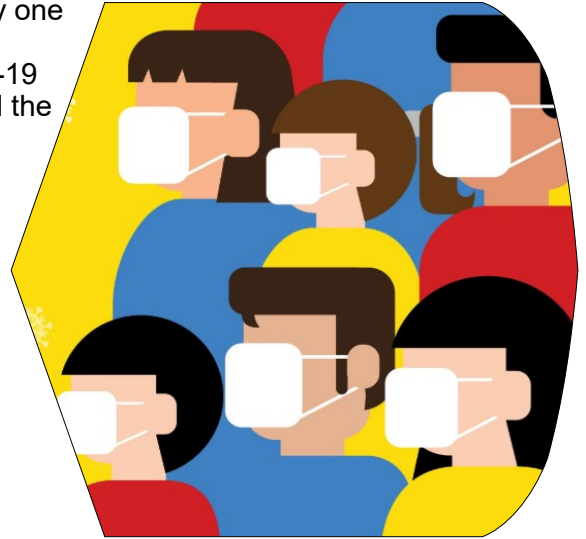

MOL Pakistan celebrates Eid al-Adha with our colleagues and our local communities

Eid al-Adha was celebrated by our colleagues with an Eid prayer the Manzalai Field Central Processing Facility (Manzalai-CPF) located in Manzalai, District Karak.



On the Islamic holiday of Eid-al-Adha, between July 31st and August 1st, MOL Pakistan distributed 45 kg of sweets in our local communities through various community leaders and community elders. Pakistani sweets, or *mithai*, are well-known confectionery desserts of the South Asian subcontinent and come in a variety of colours and flavours made from a vast array of ingredients such as different flours, milk, milk solids, fermented foods, root vegetables, raw and roasted seeds, seasonal fruits, fruit pastes and dry fruits. Typically, *mithai* is given as a gift during celebrations such as Eid, in decorated baskets known as a *tokri* or *tokra*. Therefore, MOL Pakistan gave *mithai tokras* of 5 to 10 kg each to our local communities during Eid al-Adha. This gesture of goodwill was highly appreciated and enjoyed throughout our local communities in the following villages:

Mami Khel Village, Tehsil Lachi, District Kohat; **Makori Village** and **Ahmadi Banda Village**, Tehsil Banda Daud Shah, and **Cakhtoo Village**, Tehsil Karak, of District Karak; **Anar China Village** and **Kathgar Village**, Tehsil Togh Sari, District Hangu.
