MOL Pakistan upgrades DHQ Hospital with latest Digital X-Ray System

Upholding our commitment to the betterment of communities located in our areas of operation, MOL Pakistan upgraded healthcare facilities at **Shaheed Fareed Khan Hospital District Headquarter (DHQ) Hangu, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, by providing a state-of-the-art digital x-ray system.**

A simple ceremony was held at the hospital where the digital x-ray system was formally inaugurated by Chief Guest, Mr. Khial Zaman Orakzai, MNA Hangu and Parliamentary Secretary for Petroleum. Also in attendance were Mr. Shah Faisal Khan, MPA Hangu, Mr. Ummer Awais Kiani, Assistant Commissioner Hangu, and Dr. Malik Niaz, Medical Superintendent. Members of the Hangu community, including community elder and community leaders, were also present.

MOL Pakistan donates wheelchairs to people with disabilities in our local communities

During the inauguration of the digital x-ray system, MOL Pakistan distributed wheelchairs among members of the community with disabilities hailing from the district of Hangu. The gift of mobility was greatly appreciated by recipients, who were touched by MOL Pakistan's corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiative.

All recipients could not afford to buy their own wheelchairs as they come from very poor families, with 6 to 20 family members per household, with very little education and very low incomes.

Mr. Amir Nawaz, age 18; Mr. Mujahid Khan, age 22; Mr. Muneeb ur Rahman, age 23; and Mr. Zohaib Muhammad, age 24, have been disabled since birth.

Mr. Muhammad Noman, age 22, has been disabled for the last five years due to a road accident. Mr. Mujeeb ur Rehman, age 26, has been disabled for the last one year due to a brain hemorrhage; and Mrs. Sumera Inayat Ullah, age 28, has been disabled for the last three years, also due to a brain hemorrhage.

Mr. Muhammad Zubair, age 34, has been disabled for the four years due to a stroke; and Mrs. Arshad Bibi, age 60, is an immobile cancer patient.

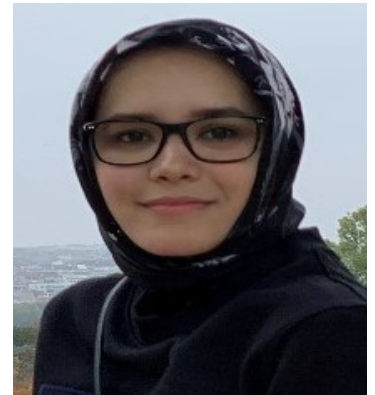
