MOL Pakistan Producing Highest Ever Quantity of LPG

MOL Pakistan is currently producing 548 metric tons per day (MTD) of LPG, at more than 129% of its name plate capacity in Pakistan. MOL Pakistan is the first and the only LPG producing company in the history of Pakistan which is producing LPG beyond its capacity.

2019 | Top HSE Performance Year For MOL Pakistan

2019 proved to be the top HSE performance year for MOL Pakistan in 20 years' history of its operations. 2019 marked completion of 02 consecutive years of MOL Pakistan's operations with no major work related personnel injury (LTI). Besides reducing spill volume by more than half of 2018, and driving 34% more distance for hydrocarbon transportation, yet still reducing road accident rate by more than half from the previous year, the team also won the MOL Group SD & HSE Chairman Award for implementing "nano-bio water treatment technology". Bolstering resolve towards sustainability, two projects are shortlisted by HQ for carbon credits in terms of GHG reduction and are to be executed in 2020 under climate change strategy initiative.



CIPS Workshop on Category and Inventory Management
