### **MOL Pakistan Provides Financial Assistance for Medical Expenses to Mother of Four in Village Jungle Khel, Tehsil Kohat, District Kohat**



MOL Pakistan's community development work in the district of Kohat is well-known and highly regarded, and where we are especially known for our positive relations with local communities. As such, our community relations officers in the field were approached by family members of Mrs. Fouzia Nasir, a 42 year old mother of four (4) young children, asking for financial assistance to help pay for her medical expenses. Without a stable source of income, her family is too poor to manage her medical expenses. In order to first pay for the surgery, Mrs. Fouzia Nasir's family had to incur a significant amount of debt and were unable to pay for any post-operative expenses due to serious complications as a result of the surgery. While Mrs. Fouzia Nasir considers herself very fortunate for living through the

complicated surgery, she lives in excruciating pain and unable to live as she once did. Her priority remains her four (4) young children. Mrs. Fouzia Nasir and her entire family are very appreciative of the financial assistance given by MOL Pakistan. They are especially grateful for the promptness of the donation, and the responsiveness of community relations officers along with the rest of the department and company.

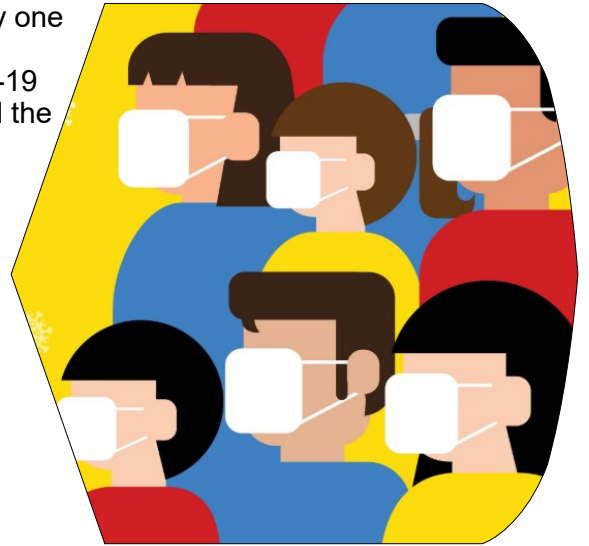

## Unprecedented Times, Unprecedented Unity: Messages from Our Colleagues

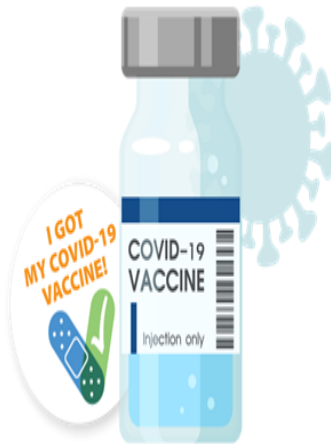
