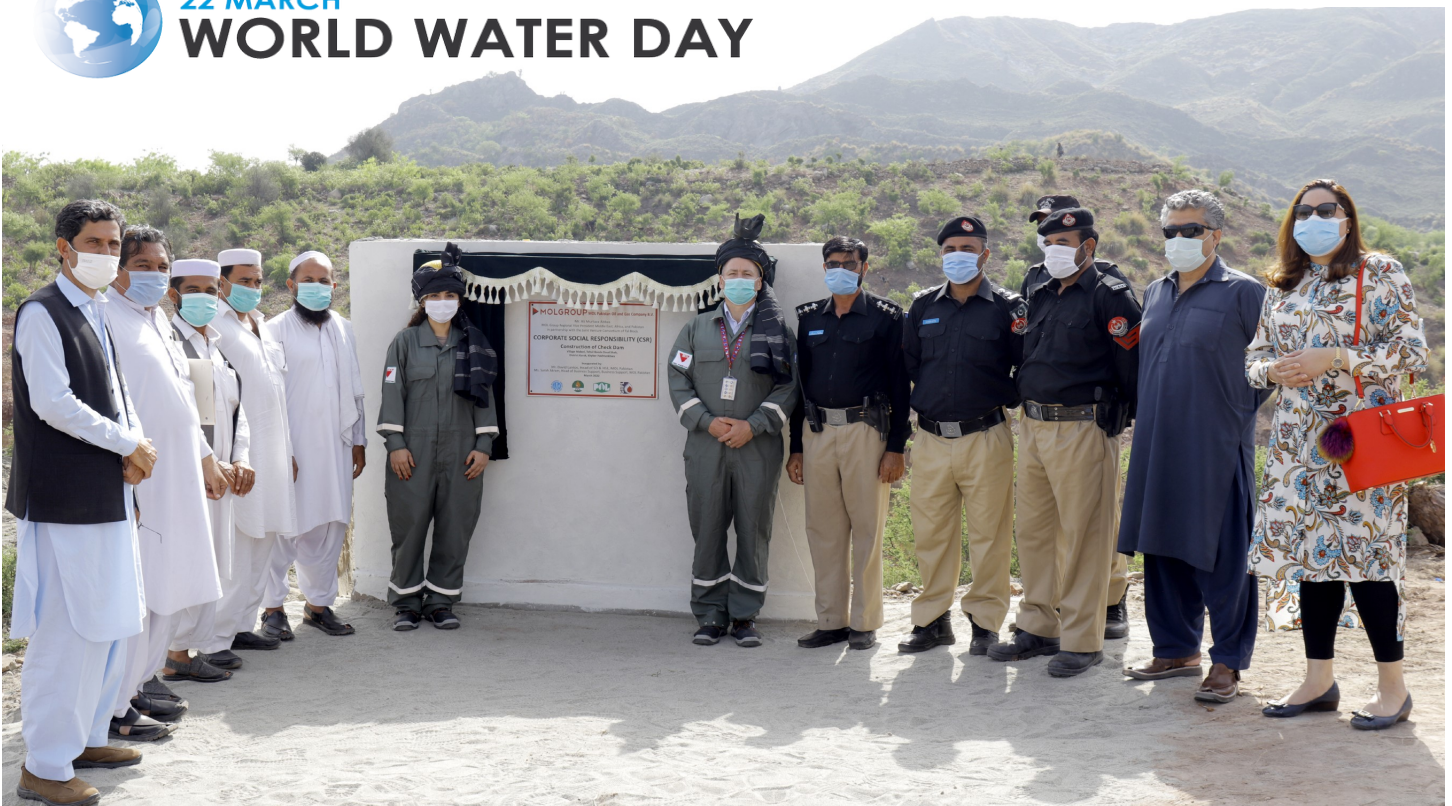
### MOL Pakistan Inaugurates Check Dam in Makori Village, District Karak

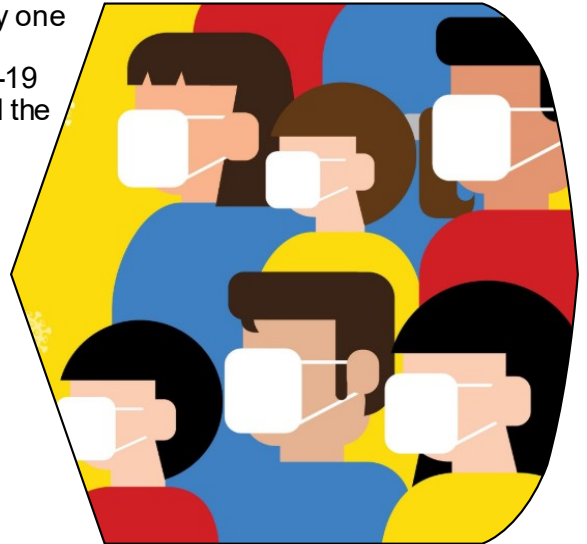

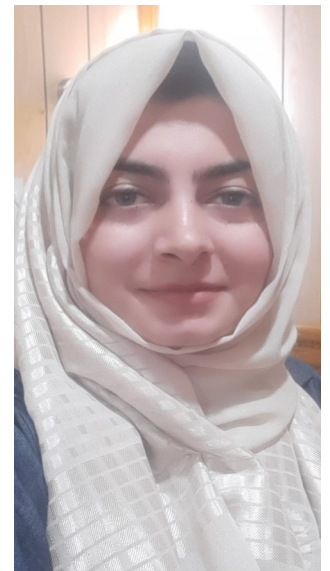
