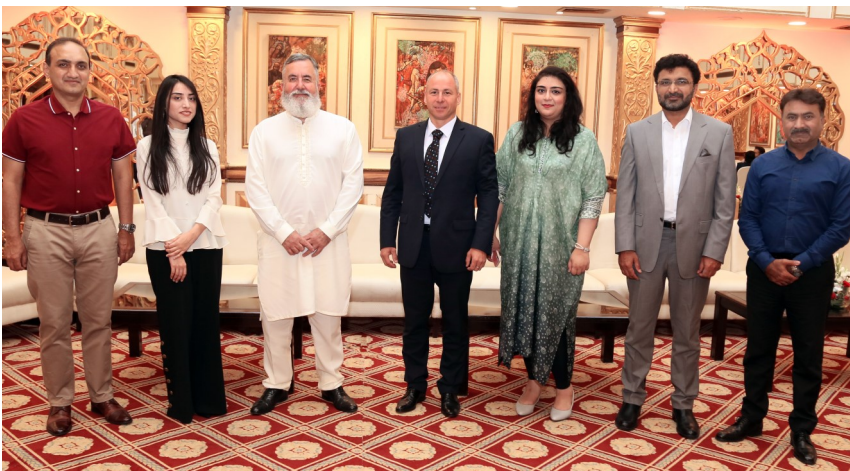
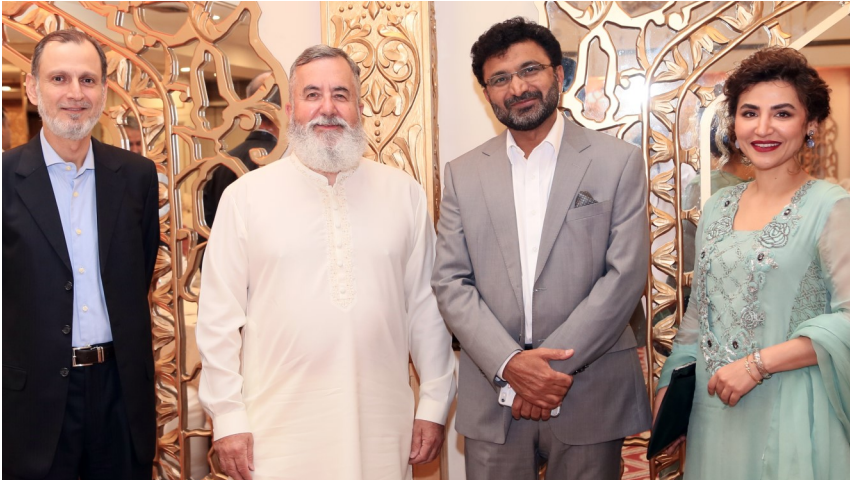

Corporate dinners in honour of Mr. Thomas Quigley, CEO MOL Pakistan

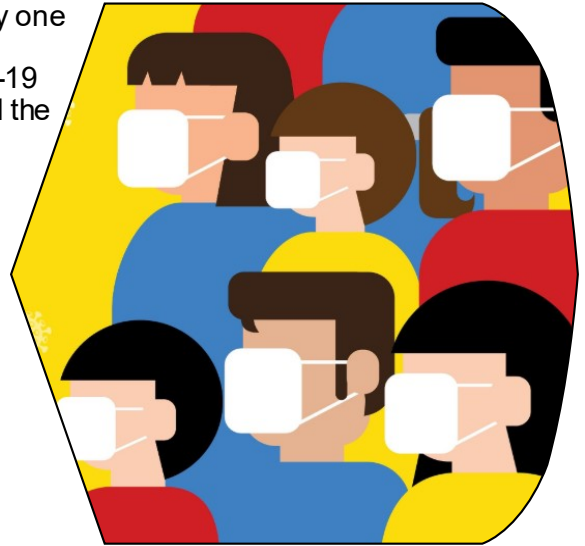
