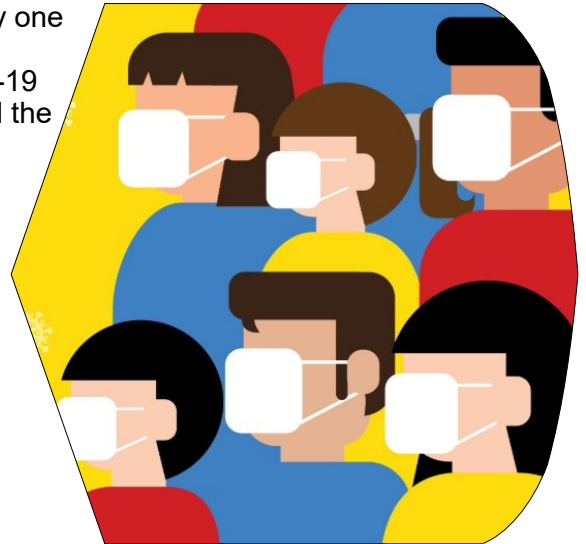

# MOL Pakistan Celebrates Hungarian National Day

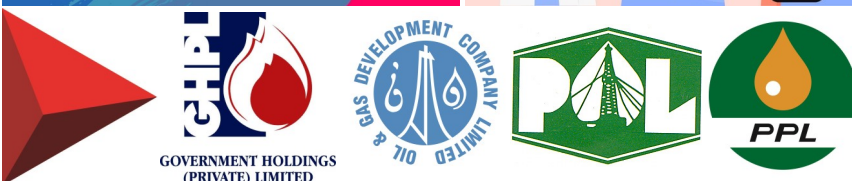
